Congressional Information Database (Combine the Congressional Information Database with either the Postal Service-based or Capitol Version Zip-to-District tables and save \$100.00 on the total price):

For the government affairs professional or organization that needs to monitor and communicate with members Congress on a timely basis, the Congressional Information Database allows you to keep up with Committee and Subcommittee assignments, district office information, and key staff. Updates are posted by 10 a.m. weekdays when Congress is in session.

For each senator and representative Congress Merge has:

- Capitol suite, phone, fax, e-contact (email or web form*), and web site
- Four top staffers (chief of staff, scheduler, legislative director, and communications person)
- Committee and subcommittee assignments
- District office information
- Biographical data
- Twitter URL
- Formal name field for composing letters to Congress

While Congress is in session all Congressional Information Database clients have the option of receiving a daily or weekly update when the following changes occur in:

- Committee or subcommittee assignments
- Office suites
- Member status, i.e., a member of Congress leaves office before the expiration of their elected term
- Special elections to fill vacant seats
- E-mail addresses
- Fax numbers
- District office information

In addition, a numerical unique ID is assigned to each member of Congress and is used throughout the database that facilitates its use in SQL databases.
